Bait & Switch, 301 20th St S – EXISTING MURAL

Artist: Vitale Brothers, St. Petersburg (2019)

This quiet, subtle mural is calmly mesmerizing. Painted in the colors of a pen and ink drawing, two versions of the same woman's face rise out of tropical leaves. Finely painted leaves in shades of black and grey surround both versions of her, clustering over both heads like a crown.

Artist: Andrea Wan, Canada

Andrea Wan is a Hong Kong-born, Vancouver-raised Visual Artist and Illustrator who has spent 8 years living in Berlin while exploring various global destinations after completing her studies in Vancouver and Denmark. She perceives her practice as a vessel for her stream of consciousness, allowing what needs to emerge. Her narratives often take on an otherworldly quality that reflects her inner world map and emotional states. With a diverse body of work encompassing ink on paper, murals, digital media, and sculptures, she delves into themes relating to nature and the intricacies of the human psyche. These topics have continuously fueled her creative practice in recent years. Andrea's works have been exhibited across Europe, North America, Australia and Asia. She is currently residing in Vancouver, BC.

Multicolored Lady, 1720 Central Ave – EXISTING MURAL

Artist: Dasic Fernandez, Chile (2016)



Born in Chile, Dasic Fernandez was lining the streets of Santiago in graffiti art till eventually moving to New York City, the spiritual home of both street art and hip hop. Celebrated internationally on lists of “Street Artists You Should Know,” Dasic is known for his figurative forms using bold colorways. His murals decorate urban landscapes from Miami to Detroit to New York.

Beneath the Shell/Ego and Identity, 1701 1st Ave S – EXISTING MURAL

Artist: Michael Reeder, New Mexico (2016)



Based in New Mexico, Michael Reeder is an exhibiting fine artist, muralist and designer, who has been named Dallas’ Muralist Of The Year and recently completed a second residency at the RedBull House of Art in Detroit. Centered on portraiture, Michael Reeder’s work mixes realism with flat graphic space, and integrates themes of identity, ambiguity and ego.

Sewing Seas, 1720 Central Ave - **EXISTING MURAL**

Artist: *Taj Tenfold, Jamaica (2019)*



Jamaican visual artist, Taj Francis, also known as Taj Tenfold, brings his distinctive reggae and hip-hop influenced aesthetic to St. Petersburg. Inspired by a mix of Japanese manga, vintage vinyl, baroque paintings, pop art and his own cultural upbringing, Francis' portraiture style work subtly reflects each unique influence while creating something entirely new.

Untitled (Samurai Warrior), 1756 Central Ave – **EXISTING MURAL**

Artist: *Jose Mertz, Miami (2017)*



An artist and image-maker based in Miami, Jose Mertz pushes an experimental style inspired by ancient civilizations, science fiction, eastern philosophy, and the supernatural. Embracing multimedia platforms, his work ranges from traditional painting and murals, to product design on t-shirts and stickers.

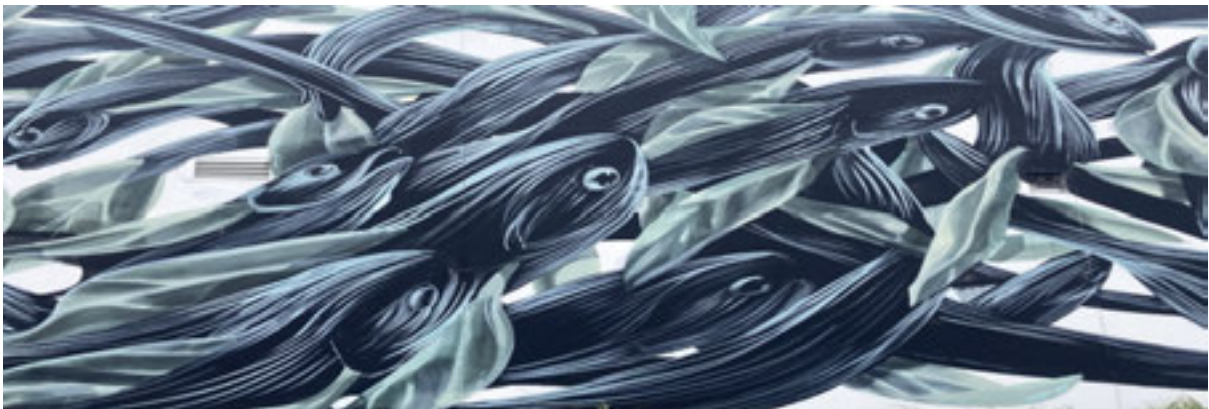
Vitale Bros, Gulfport (2018)



Johnny and his brother, Paul have been painting the town since the early 90s. Their work has fans everywhere. "We love St. Pete and we like what the mural thing has done to it. It's put us on the map," said Paul. "It's obviously working as a positive force in the community for tourism and whatnot and there's mural tours and all kinds of stuff," said Johnny. They've even restored damaged murals for free.

A Swarm of Fish, 1950 1st Ave N – EXISTING MURAL

Artist: Pantonio, Portugal (2016)



From the islands of Azores, Pantonio is a Portuguese street artist who creates distinct and stylized swarms of fish, birds and other animals that visually flow, weave and move as they come to life on the wall. Using soft composition and a minimalist color palette, Pantonio's large-scale murals are celebrated from France to Ukraine to Morocco.

Untitled (Dancer), 2201 Central Ave – **EXISTING MURAL**

Artist: *James Bullough, Germany (2022)*



James Bullough is an American born artist living and working in Berlin, Germany. His studio paintings, and huge monumentally scaled site-specific murals combine delicately handled realistic portraiture with harsh graphic distortion and abstraction. Inspired by the gritty urban graffiti he saw as a young artist growing up in Washington, DC, Bullough harnessed it's energy and edge while teaching himself more traditional realistic oil painting techniques by studying the Old Masters. Combining the momentum of the one and the technical precision of the other, his work is about staging compelling contrasts and juxtapositions. Whether working with spray paint on massive facades or oils in his studio, Bullough's work strikes a delicate balance between realistic portraiture and stylized distortions, straddling the space between traditional and contemporary. Bullough's studio work has been exhibited at numerous galleries, museums, and art fairs across the globe and with multiple sold-out solo shows to his name his work continues to be in high demand. His murals can be found worldwide with landmark pieces in New Zealand, Sweden, France, Germany, Ukraine, and throughout the US.

Space Babe Invades, 2421 Central Ave – **EXISTING MURAL**

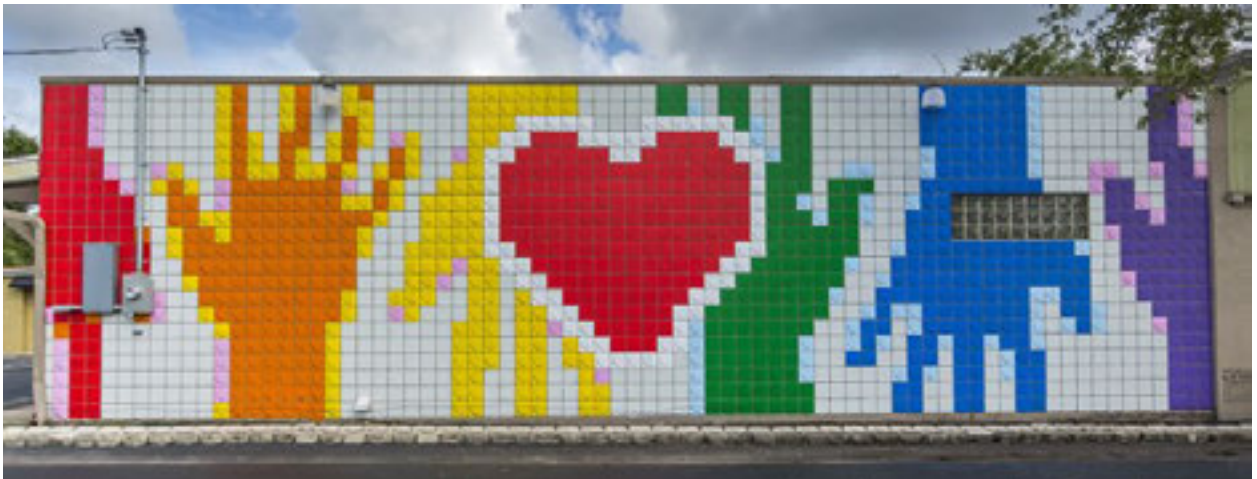
Artist: Ashley Cantero, Tampa (2022)



Ashley Cantero is a Tampa, FL native and artist who actively engages in the local art scene. Best known for her precise line work and bold female characters, her work embodies a profound energy that she defines as the “intense and complex emotional responses we have to the world around us.” With themes inspired by ‘60s psychedelia, Atomic Age design and Sci-Fi, Ashley's work is ever evolving through various mediums and artistic forms of expression.

Pride & Love, 2437 Central Ave – **EXISTING MURAL**

Jay Hoff, St Petersburg (2019)



Jay Hoff uses Lego bricks as his artistic medium, to create imaginative artwork and surprisingly realistic portraits. On his first mural, he translated the idea of Lego bricks into real bricks on a wall, 12 feet high and 50 feet wide. Jay even used a stencil to paint the official Lego logo on each brick, so it looks as if the wall is really made of Legos.

Case Maclaim, Germany (2021)



German artist Andres Von Chrzanowski, better known as Case Maclaim, is a street artist whose work brilliantly combines photorealism with a strong note of surrealism. Best known for his depiction of overlaying hands, Case's work symbolizes power and unity. He is a founding member of the renowned Maclaim Crew, a group that has been pioneering photorealism in the streets for over two decades. His murals can be found in over 20 countries around the world.

With more than a decade of experience as a professional illustrator and fine artist, Chris Parks, better known as Palehorse, creates highly detailed work that draws influence from his roots and an ongoing fascination for Southeast Asian and Latin culture, mythology and spiritual practices. His clients include Under Armour, Modelo, Sonos, Hasbro and WWE, and his gallery work has been exhibited in Miami during Art Basel, Los Angeles, New York, Berlin, Jakarta and more. He is also a founding member of the SHINE St. Petersburg Mural Festival, serving as co-curator and organizer from 2015-2017.

123Klan, Los Angeles



123Klan is a French graffiti crew, composed of husband and wife team Scien and Klor, who have dominated the street art scene for more than 25 years. By shifting the boundaries of their two favorite disciplines, graffiti art and graphic design, 123KLAN have advanced the graffiti aesthetics and infused a healthy dose of new ideas into current graphic design. Now living in Los Angeles, 123Klan's bold character design and iconography has helped them establish a client list from Sony to Scion to KidRobot, while holding true to their graffiti roots.

DAAS, Japan (2018)



DAAS is a Japan based Florida artist with a distinct geometric style, using lines and angles reminiscent of origami folds.
